

Student Affairs Statement to Students in Garland Hall (Evening of April 3)

“I have a short statement. As our guidelines around student protests emphasize, our primary aim is to support free expression. Thus, in working with the student protest leaders, we have agreed to permit the students in the Garland lobby to spend the night here, in spite of the fact that the building is officially closed from 6 pm to the following 7 am on weekdays.

In doing so, we will follow our normal procedures of having our own Hopkins Security monitor and support this protest, barring any criminal activity or other significant public safety threat.”
