Opportunity Summary:

MOMENTUM seeks to accelerate reductions in maternal, newborn, and child mortality and morbidity in high-burden, USAID-supported countries by increasing the capacity of host country institutions and local organizations to introduce, deliver, scale up, and sustain the use of evidence-based, quality maternal, newborn, and child health (MNCH), voluntary family planning (FP) and reproductive health (RH) services. MOMENTUM is designed to build upon existing evidence and best practices, as well as to catalyze new ideas, partnerships, and approaches.

MOMENTUM will include a greater focus on building the capacity, sustainability, and resilience of local partner institutions, while maintaining an emphasis on advancing the scale-up of evidence-based approaches and interventions. Awards will seek to issue performance-based, capacity-building, and/or innovation sub-awards and sub-grants to local organizations which may, in time, become transition awards.¹⁰ All sub-awards to local organizations will specify clear, achievable, and measurable outcomes mapped to priority health indicators, and connect to specific, national priorities and milestones on the journey to self-reliance.

<u>Round 1:</u> MNCH/FP/RH Service Delivery in Fragile Settings (\$200M) <u>Round 2A:</u> Global Technical Leadership and Targeted Technical Assistance for MNCH/FP/RH (\$100M) <u>Round 2B:</u> Targeted MNCH/FP/RH Technical Assistance to Private Providers (\$75M) <u>Round 2C:</u> MOMENTUM Monitoring and Evaluation, Knowledge Management and Translation (\$25M)

Eligibility & Requirements:

• Cost share is required in each Round (unless otherwise stated) and will be provided in the request for full applications. Amount range will vary. Mobilization of funds from outside sources through cost share of award activities is highly encouraged.

Internal Nomination Process:

Interested applicants should submit the following documents:

- 1. JHU Limited Submission Cover Sheet
- 2. A statement confirming which Round you are applying for
- Proposal (maximum of two pages of text only, single spaced: 12-pt font and one-inch margins) (Note: figures, tables, and other reference material may be included in addition to the 2 pg. text limit)
- 4. Curriculum Vitae of investigator, including current external research support and publications
