Good afternoon/morning.

In response to your June emails requesting a meeting, we would like to offer two potential dates and times: Wednesday, July 24th 9:00 – 10:00am or Thursday, July 25th 3:00 – 4:00pm.

This meeting would be for a small group of current students, representing the SAPP and Anti-ICE coalitions, to meet with university leaders (including the President and Provost among others). Similar to the previously scheduled meetings, the purpose of this meeting will be to discuss substantive issues of concern for your groups. We require the names of student attendees 48 hours in advance. As we have done in the past, we will send you the names of the university leaders attending.

As we move forward in developing a Johns Hopkins Police Department, we will continue to offer opportunities for input and to hear the views of our students, faculty, and staff and community. As we've said previously, while we can't privilege one group of students above others, we know it is important for us to connect with many different groups to hear a broad range of thoughts.
