In response to your message I want to make one more attempt to gain your cooperation in order to allow the meeting offered by the President, Provost and other university leaders to go forward tomorrow. The meeting invitation stands as set forth in my prior emails. I also still need confirmation from you by 7:30pm today that, in addition to the two requested faculty, only the students on the RSVP list that you sent yesterday—not a “legal observer” and not any other persons unaffiliated with the university—will be in attendance. If you are unwilling to engage in this substantive, small group discussion of issues as students and university leaders, we will cancel the meeting.
